CUVÉE 2019

VARIETIES: 100% Tempranillo from our vineyards located in Haro, in the heart of Rioja Alta region.

2019 VINTAGE: Following an early budburst, the growing season concluded with berry weights that were stable and higher than the previous year, alongside perfect phenolic ripening. The light rain in September, combined with the arrival of northern winds and cooler nighttime temperatures during the harvest, defined the freshness, precision and balance characteristic of the 2019 vintage. The Rioja Regulatory Council awarded this vintage a classification of 'Very Good.'

ELABORATION: Selective manual harvesting in our parcels around Haro ensured optimal ripeness of the grape clusters. Traditional winemaking methods were employed, including destemming, light crushing, and fermentation in stainless steel tanks. In the summer of 2020, the wine began its aging process in American oak barrels. During the 18 months in barrel, three rackings were carried out using traditional techniques. Once bottled, the wine continues to evolve, refining in our bottle cellar for several months.

TASTING NOTES: High aromatic intensity with a predominant expression of ripe fruits: raspberries, red cherries, and wild strawberries, layered over a balsamic background of vanilla, toasted caramel, biscuits, coffee, and sweet mint. On the palate, it shows great presence and balance, with good acidity and soft, approachable tannins. The harmonious aromatic profile persists in the aftertaste, featuring notes of red fruit preserves, prunes, coffee, vanilla, and caramel.
