CUVÉE 2020

VARIETIES: 100% Tempranillo from our vineyards in Haro, in the heart of the Rioja Alta region.

2020 VINTAGE: After a growing season plagued by drought, the rains at the end of September had a very positive effect on ripening, giving the berries a better balance at the end. The harvested grapes were in an excellent state of ripeness, with a good balance of alcohol, acidity, aromas and polyphenols. This allowed us to produce high quality wines that are truly representative of the traits of our vineyards. The Rioja Control Board awarded this vintage a 'Very Good' rating.

ELABORATION: The grapes were harvested by hand, allowing for the selection of clusters in the vineyard, harvesting grapes at optimum ripeness. Traditional vinification was carried out, with destemming, light crushing and fermentation in stainless steel tanks. In January 2021, the wine was aged in American oak barrels for 22 months. The wine was racked four times using traditional methods and bottled at the end of 2022.

TASTING NOTES: High aromatic intensity with a predominance of ripe fruit: raspberries, red cherries, wild strawberries and redcurrants over a balsamic background of vanilla, toasted caramel, biscuits, coffee and sweet mint. On the palate, it has good acidity, great freshness and balance and soft, pleasant tannins. Soft and pleasant tannins. The aromatic harmony persists in the aftertaste, with notes of red fruit jam, prunes, coffee, vanilla and caramel.

Alcohol content: 14%. **pH:** 3.65. **Acidity:** 5.1 grams per litre
